### **Summary:**

A busy month resulted in 13 pieces of coverage, the majority of which came from two comments, one in response to Master McCloud's final judgment and the second in response to the Oakwood v Menzies Supreme Court judgment.

Elsewhere, we have been coordinating with Carol Calver on the social media calendar and have shared posts about the upcoming Costs Lawyer awards with Lexis Nexis and Modern Law. Additionally, we have reported back to PRAM following discussions with the CLSB about how we can gather data on the costs associated with a Costs Lawyer and charge out rates.
