The changes include:

- 1. Setting out recommended additional hours where there are additional parties to be assessed by an expert for a psychological or psychiatric assessment
- 2. All parties covered by a prior authority granted to the lead solicitor
- 3. Inclusion of cases of physical and domestic abuse in the risk assessment provisions
- 4. Setting out that where a court order lists all the documents required to be translated documents there is no need to apply for prior authority
- 5. New guideline rates in annex 5 for some experts
